Dear Sirs,

I am writing on behalf of the carnival committee as a courtesy to outline the arrangements now authorised and that will be put in place for this year's Carnival taking place on Saturday 21st November 2015. As a result there will be some disruption to access into Glastonbury over that weekend and this advice is intended to help you to put your own plans in place, and to enable you to pass on relevant information to your staff and customers, and to their families and other local residents.

On Friday 20th November the A39 By-pass between the Northload and 'Tin Bridge' roundabouts will closed at approximately 08:00pm and will then remain closed right through the weekend until approximately 10:00am on Sunday (22nd November). During this period diversions will be in place for through traffic: towards Wells going via Street Road (A361), Magdalene Street, up the High Street (one way only), and along Wells Road to rejoin the A39 at the 'Tin Bridge' roundabout. Traffic coming from Wells will be diverted into Wells Road, then Lambrook Street and Chilkwell Street, into Bere Lane and down Fishers Hill, and along Street Road (A361) to rejoin the A39 at the Wyrral Park roundabout.

On Saturday 21st November from 05:00pm all roads into Glastonbury will be closed for the duration of the Carnival. They will reopen progressively from about 10:00pm as the procession passes, working its way along the section of the By-pass between Northload and Wyrral Park roundabout, along Street Road, Magdalene Street and the High Street and finishing in Wells Road (by St Dunstan's School). Local traffic will be restricted and unable to get in or out of the town centre, but access for Emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

The principal road closure points will be:
Wells Road, at the junction with Brindham Lane (near West Mendip Hospital);
Street Road / The Causeway (A39) at the Street roundabout;
Top of Fishers Hill (A361);
A map will be available on our website.

We look forward to a spectacular carnival for the enjoyment of everyone as well as raising monies for good causes, and thank you for your understanding and cooperation. The event does afford opportunities to become more involved and to contribute to its fundraising efforts such as by means of sponsorship or by advertising in the programme.
